# NCCF Scholarship Awards

Facts and Figures



In 2023, NCCF awarded \$1,291,640 in direct scholarship aid to 309 students from across North Carolina.

- 347 individual scholarships were awarded from 115 NCCF scholarship funds in 2023.
- 95 of the 2023 NCCF scholars are first-generation college students.
- This year's NCCF scholarship recipients hail from 131 North Carolina cities and towns, and they are now studying at 68 different schools in 15 states across the country.
- This year, 225 scholarships totaling \$856,122 were awarded to female scholars; 121 scholarships totaling \$430,518 were awarded to male scholars; and one scholarship totaling \$5,000 was awarded to a gender nonconforming scholar.
- 54 of the current NCCF scholars will graduate in the 2023-2024 academic year!

 43 of the schools attended by 2023 NCCF scholars are in North Carolina, meaning \$1,139,712 in scholarship dollars stayed right here in our state.

# 2023 NCCF scholars attend:

- 12 public universities in North Carolina, totaling \$918,169 in aid.
- 17 private colleges and universities in North Carolina, totaling \$169,199 in aid.
- 14 community colleges in North Carolina, totaling \$52,344 in aid.
